- Follow the photography brief and event run sheet provided to you pre-event, working with the other photographers to ensure you capture everything required.
- Providing and using your own camera and photography gear.
- Report to the Event Manager at the end of your shift and provide 10 of your best photos from the event prior to your departure.
- Provide all event photos on a memory stick within 48 hours. Event Manager will confirm details.
- Be mindful and ensure that anyone who objects to being photographed, is not included in any photos.
- Reporting any risks, hazards and incidents to Mission Australia staff.
- Refer any medical situations to the St John Ambulance First Aid station outside.
- Refer any unsafe situations to Security.
- Eating lunch! Just check time with the Event Manager, collecting from the Food & Beverage Supervisor.
