## As Water Station Crew, your contribution is

- Support our guests' enjoyment of Christmas Lunch in the Park, through your warm, friendly attitude and your active, can-do approach. **And, of course, to have fun!**
- Cheerfully greet guests as they approach the drinking water station.
- Wearing gloves, you'll take their water bottle from them and re-fill it for them, ensuring a hygienic re-fill every time.
- Ensure guests are social distancing while waiting for their re-fill, ensuring a quick pace of filling to alleviate long queues.
- If you leave the water filling area, be sure to change your gloves upon return to maintain high standards of hygiene at all times.
- Make sure you eat lunch and stay hydrated! Just check with your Floor Supervisor before collecting your lunch from the F&B Supervisor.
- Help maintain your zone, ensuring areas are kept clear and rubbish is disposed. We'll all refrain from packing up at the end of the event, until after the official close and as advised by supervisors.
- **Remember to wear gloves and follow any social distancing requirements at all times.**
- **Report all incidents, issues or concerns to your Floor Supervisor, no matter how small it may seem.**
